






The different roles have different responsibility

Overall structure and different roles

The structure of the Lillehammer 2016 organisation follows the C3 principles, where the Functional Areas (FA), the Venue Managers and the Main Operations Centre (MOC) are important coordinating roles.

Importance of communication

The YOG is a complex event involving may different stakeholders, clients and venues. The risk of matters involving several functions and venues are significant, and there is a need for active and sufficient communication between the FAs, Venue Managers and the MOC. Communication between the coordinating roles should happen both in formalised reports and in informal dialogue.

Issue solving

Issues shall be solved at the lowest appropriate level. Still, when issues are solved at FAs and/or venues, it might be necessary to inform the MOC of both issue and how it was solved. Relevant issues will be tracked in a issue tracking tool managed by the MOC and discussed with the IOC during fixed conf calls three times a day during YOG Period.






C3 Framework – Key Tasks

- Identify partners
 - police, fire brigade, city operations, medical, etc.
- Identify risks → determine actions
- Define authority
- Clarify «chain of command»
- Determine tools of communication
- Establish MOC
